NOTIFICATION

CONSTITUTION OF INDIA.

No Akruvi-1299/Case No.299/15-A.— In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India and in supersession of all existing rules, orders or instruments made in this behalf, the Governor of Maharashtra is hereby pleased to make the following rules regulating recruitment to the posts of Agriculture Supervisor/Laboratory Inspector/Computer (Statistical Branch) and Agriculture Assistant/Laboratory

Assistant in Group 'C' in the Commissionerate of Agriculture under the Agriculture, Animal Husbandry, Dairy Development and Fisheries Department of the Government of Maharashtra, namely :—

1. These rules may be called the Agriculture Supervisor/Laboratory Inspector/Computer (Statistical Branch) and Agriculture Assistant/Laboratory Assistant in Group 'C' in the Commissionerate of Agriculture under the Agriculture, Animal Husbandry, Dairy Development and Fisheries Department (Recruitment) Rules, 2004.

2. In these rules unless the context requires otherwise,—

(a) "Commissionerate" means the Commissionerate of Agriculture ;

(b) "Degree" means an Agriculture/Agriculture Engineering/Agriculture Vaniki (Horticulture) degree of a statutory university ;

(c) "Diploma" means a diploma in Agriculture of statutory board or university ;

(d) "Department" means a Agriculture, Animal Husbandry, Dairy Development and Fisheries Department ;

(e) "Government" means the Government of Maharashtra.

3. Appointment to the posts of Agriculture Supervisor/Laboratory Inspector/Computer (Statistical Branch) in Group 'C' in the Commissionerate, shall be made either,—

(a) by promotion of a suitable person, on the basis of seniority subject to fitness from amongst the persons holding the posts of Agriculture Assistant/Laboratory Assistant, Group 'C' having not less than three years regular service in that post :

Provided that, the ratio for promotion amongst the persons who possess a degree and who do not possess a degree, diploma shall be 60 : 40 of the vacancies available for promotion ; or

(b) by nomination from amongst candidates who,—

(i) are not more than 30 years of age ;

(ii) possess a degree or any other qualification recognised by the Government to be equivalent thereto ;

(c) appointment by promotion and nomination, shall be made in the ratio of 70 : 30, respectively.

4. Appointment to the post of Agriculture Assistant/Laboratory Assistant in Group ' C ' in the Commissionerate, shall be made either,—

(a) by promotion of a suitable person on the basis of seniority subject to fitness from amongst the persons holding the posts of Nursery Assistant (Mali) Group ' D ', having not less than seven years regular service in that post ; or

(b) by nomination from amongst the candidates who,—

(1) are not more than 30 years of age ;

(2) possess a degree or diploma of a statutory board or university, or any other qualifications recognised by the Government to be equivalent thereto ;

(3) appointment by promotion and nomination, shall be made in the ratio of 1 : 9, respectively.

5. A person appointed to the posts mentioned in rules 3 and 4 by promotion or nomination, shall be required to pass the departmental examination and examination in Hindi and Marathi, unless he has already passed or has been exempted from passing these examinations according to the rules made in that behalf.

6. A person appointed to the posts mentioned in rules 3 and 4 in a particular agriculture division of the Agriculture, Animal Husbandry, Dairy Development and Fisheries Department, shall be liable for transfer anywhere in the said division.

7. A person appointed to the posts mentioned in rules 3 and 4, should possess a certificate in computer operation prescribed by the Director of Information Technology, Government of Maharashtra, from time to time.
