CONSTITUTION OF INDIA.

No. Duvia. 5687/415/(62/87)/ADF-7.— In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India and in supersession of all existing rules, orders or instruments made in this behalf the Governor of Maharashtra is hereby pleased to make the following rules regulating recruitment to the post of Live Stock Supervisor, Class-III in the Dairy Development Department under the Agriculture, Animal Husbandry, Dairy Development and Fisheries Department of the Government of Maharashtra, namely :—

1. These rules may be called the Live Stock Supervisor in the Dairy Development Department (Recruitment) Rules, 1990.

2. In these rules, unless the context requires otherwise,—

(a) “Dairy Development Department” means the Dairy Development Department of Government.

(b) “Government” means the Government of Maharashtra.

(c) “Recognised Institution” means an institution recognised by Government.

(d) "Secondary School Certificate Examination" means the final Examination conducted at the end of the Secondary Stage of Education by a Divisional Board established under the Maharashtra Secondary and Higher Secondary Education Boards Act, 1965 (Mah. XLI of 1965) and includes any other examination declared by Government to be equivalent thereto.

3. Appointment to the post of Live Stock Supervisor in the Dairy Development Department, shall be made,—

(a) by transfer of a suitable person holding the post of Live Stock Supervisor in Animal Husbandry Department possessing the qualifications prescribed for appointment by nomination in clause (b) of this rule ; or

(b) by nomination from amongst candidates who,—

(i) unless already in the service of Government are not more than 28 years of age ; and

(ii) have passed Live Stock Supervisor's Training Course conducted by the "Directorate of Animal Husbandry, Maharashtra State, Bombay or by any statutory Agricultural University in the State of Maharashtra or by other State ; or

(iii) possess two years' Diploma Course in the Dairy Farm Management and Animal Husbandry conducted by the Board of Technical Examination, Bombay after passing the Secondary School Certificate Examination :

Provided that the age limit may be relaxed by Government on the recommendation of appointing authority or Selecting Authority in favour of candidates having exceptional qualifications or experience or both.

4. A person appointed to the post by nomination shall be on probation for a period of one year.

5. A person appointed to the post whether by transfer or nomination shall be required to pass the Departmental Examination and Examinations in Hindi and Marathi according to the rules made in that behalf, unless he has already passed, or has been exempted from passing those examinations.

6. A person appointed to the post shall be liable for transfer anywhere in the State of Maharashtra.
