CONSTITUTION OF INDIA.

No. Duvia. 5687/415/(62/87)/ADF-7.— In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India and in supersession of all existing rules and orders issued in this behalf, the Governor of Maharashtra is hereby pleased to make the following rules gulating recruitment to the posts of Milk Procurement Supervisor and Milk Distribution Supervisor, Class-III in the Dairy Development Department under the Agriculture, Animal Husbandry, Dairy Development and Fisheries Department of the Government of Maharashtra, namely :—

1. These rules may be called the Milk Procurement Supervisor and Milk Distribution Supervisor in the Dairy Development Department (Recruitment) Rules, 1990.

2. In these rules, unless the context requires otherwise,—

(a) "Government" means the Government of Maharashtra ;

(b) "Secondary School Certificate Examination" means the final examination conducted at the end of the Secondary Stage of Education by a Divisional Board Established under the Maharashtra Secondary and Higher Secondary Education Boards Act, 1965 (Mah. XLI of 1965) and includes any other examination declared by Government to be equivalent thereto.

3. Appointment to the post of Milk Procurement Supervisor and Milk Distribution Supervisor in the Dairy Development shall be made by nomination from amongst candidates who,—

(a) unless already in the service of Government are not less than 18 years and not more than 28 years of age ; and

(b) possess two years agricultural Diploma Course after Secondary School Certificate Examination from any Agricultural School or Institute recognised by the Statutory Agricultural Universities in the State ; or

(c) possesses two years Diploma Course in Dairy Farm Management and Animal Husbandry, conducted by the Board of Technical Examination, Maharashtra State, Bombay, or by the Statutory Agricultural Universities in the State after passing the Secondary School Certificate Examination :

Provided that, the age limit, may be relaxed by Government on the recommendation of appointing authority or by the selecting authority in favour of candidates having exceptional qualifications or experience or both.

4. A person appointed to the post shall be on probation for a period of one year.

5. A person appointed to the post shall be required to pass the Departmental Examination and examinations in Hindi and Marathi according to the rules made in that behalf, unless he has already passed or has been exempted from passing those examinations.

6. A person appointed to the post shall be liable for transfer anywhere in the State of Maharashtra.
