Recruitment Rule for the post of Assistant Security Officer, Greater Bombay Milk Scheme.

Appointment shall be made either :

(A) by promotion of a suitable Class III Officer working in the Dairy Development Department possessing experience mentioned in

* (iii) below :

(B) by transfer of a suitable officer from the Police Department of the rank of sub-Inspector of Police possessing the experience mentioned in c(iii) below; or

(C) by nomination from amongst candidates who -

- i) unless already in the service of the Government of Maharashtra, are not more than 35 years of age;
- ii) have passed S.S.C. of any other equivalent examination recognised by Government;
- iii) have experience of not less than 5 years of Police or security work in Government or in an Industrial Undertaking.
- iv) possess the following physical standards -
 - (a) Height - Not less than 1 metre 65 cms. (that is, 5' - 5"); and
 - (b) chest - 84 cms. with a minimum expansion of 5 cms.

2. A candidate appointed by nomination shall be on probation for a period of one year.

3. A candidate whether appointed by promotion, transfer or nomination shall be required to pass departmental and regional language examinations and an examination in Hindi according to the prescribed rules.
